#### "CONGRESSES" IS NOW "CALENDAR"


This release has made some changes to terminology used in My ABF. This has arisen because the "Congresses" page has increasingly expanded and is now used by clubs to list all sorts of events, besides what most of us understand to be congresses. As a result the page title had become quite misleading.

#### Therefore:


- The main page has been renamed to "Calendar" with some other title changes as well.
- The same change has been made in the logged out view of My ABF and in the Club Admin menu.
- The basic structure and screens for listing events remains the same, however. And the term "Congress" remains in place in several key areas:
  - o When setting up events
  - Within the options of "Event type"
  - In the Club Admin finance area where a club can summarise transactions by Congress or by Event within a Congress.
- In a club's Public Information (profile) page it's always been possible to include a section listing upcoming congresses. That section is also now described as calendar with upcoming events.

#### 1. The main menu

The ordering of the main menu on the left hand side of the screen has been changed. What used to be Congresses (now Calendar) is now the first item after the dashboard as that is the most common place users visit.



#### 2. The main screen




The following changes have been made:


- The main menu item and main header is now "Calendar" instead of "Congresses"
- The link to view past events now says "View completed events" instead of "View completed congresses"
- The "Congress Type" filter has been changed to "Event Type" (but the selection options are the same)
- 4 The "Congress" title has changed to just say "Name"
- 5 The "Congress Type" title has changed to say "Event Type"

## 3. When not logged into My ABF

This screen now refers to Calendar and Upcoming Events instead of Upcoming Congresses:




#### 4. The club admin menu



The "Congresses" menu item has changed to "Calendar". At this stage, however, the content within that section is unchanged. In time there will be updates to this.

# 5. A club's profile page (from the Public Information selection in Communications)



The bottom table has changed to describe events rather than specifically congresses. Previously it looked like this:
